1. Report Summary

A report to councillors regarding an application for parish boundary changes from Winterbourne Parish Council.

2. Background

In 2020 Winterbourne Parish Council requested Wiltshire Council to alter the boundary between the two parishes near to Broken Cross Bridge at Ford. WCIlr McLennan has advised that this will be considered in the coming group of requests that are being considered by the Electoral Review Committee.


3. Summary

In a letter from Winterbourne Parish Council, they state their reasons for the application as:-

We included in our original submission the observation that our parish boundary bisects the building complexes associated with Ford Farm, off Malthouse Lane where properties appear to be split between Winterbourne, Firsdawn and Laverstock & Ford parishes. We have not yet developed a specific proposal on the boundaries at this location, in part because we do not have sufficient detail on land ownership.

We have also highlighted Long Close, Winterbourne Earls as a point for consideration as it appears to us that this property is very close indeed to the settlements of the Winterbournes and the postal address could imply that it is part of the Winterbournes.
