1. Report Summary

2. Background

Anti-social behaviour, large-scale littering, illegal rubbish-dumping and crime have increasingly become issues of concern in the Laverstock and Ford Parish-Council constituency. The Parish Council is adamant to address these issues in a strategic manner in order to prevent further escalation. The Council is aware that a coordinated response involving all stakeholders (such as the police, Wiltshire Council authorities and representatives, local businesses, schools, housing associations, NGOs, and local residents) is essential.

3. Recommendations

The Parish Council resolves to organise an all-stakeholder meeting addressing different forms of anti-social behaviour, large-scale littering, illegal rubbish-dumping and crime. The meeting serves the purpose of

- gathering all relevant actors around one table;
- raising awareness of their respective roles, powers, and responsibilities;
- and jointly and progressively identifying further action and solutions.
