<p>Subject:</p>	<p>LHFIF Issue 13-23-19 Riverbourne Road</p> <p>Dangerous turning into Riverbourne Road from Queen Manor Road. Car's park on the corner and force cars entering to change lane.</p>

<p>Purpose of Report:</p>	<p>A report to councillors regarding Parish Council contributions to Local Highways and Footpath Group LHFIF scheme.</p>
<p>Background:</p>	<p>In September 2024 the location and design plan for the proposed waiting restrictions at Riverbourne Rd/Queen Manor Rd were sent to LFPC for agreement. The design plan included yellow lines to be added to St Johns Close and on Queen Manor Road as well as on Riverbourne Road (which was not originally asked for).</p> <p>Cllr Laura Jones asked local residents directly affected what if the additional yellow lines were wanted.</p> <p>The overwhelming feeling from 1, 2 Queen Manor Road, 1,2,3,4,5 Riverbourne Road was that double yellows are NOT required or wanted on Queen Manor Road nor on St Johns Close. Yellow lines are only wanted on the corner of Riverbourne Road.</p> <p>New design (see below) sent through in December 2024.</p>
<p>Key Points:</p>	 <p>Dangerous turning into Riverbourne Road from Queen Manor Road. Car's park on the corner and force cars entering to change lane.</p> <p>Support from local residents affected. LHFIF were sent emails and letters written in support.</p> <p>LHFIF voted in support and agreed 75% LHFIF contribution of £2998.50.</p>

L&F to agree contribution of 25% at £999.50.
