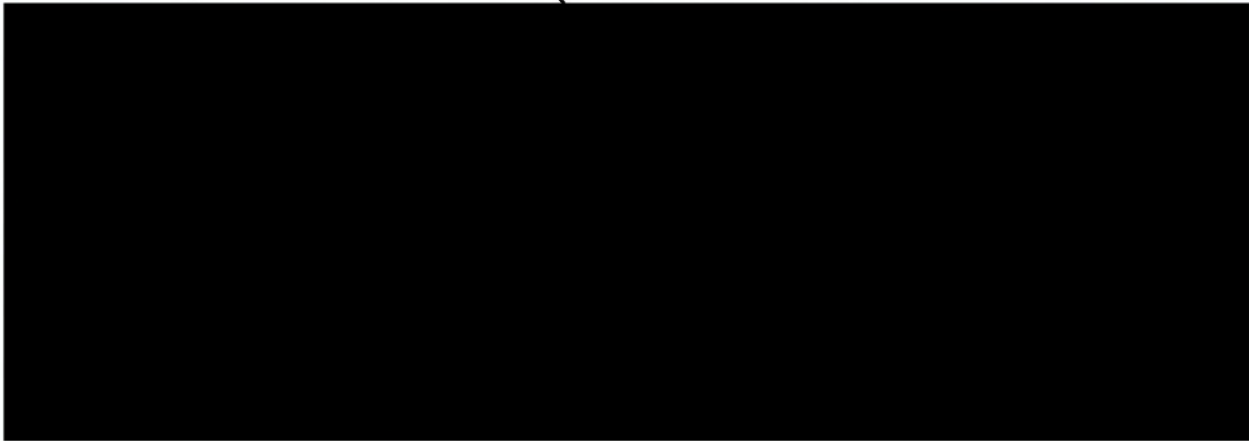

	We began a TODDLER GROUP back in February 2026 - a space for parents/carers to bring under 5's of a Tuesday afternoon. We use the main hall, kitchen and outside space to enable play. We offer listening ears and support to those who come, as well as home-made cake and liquid refreshments. The group is open to everyone with under 5's

	We probably 'fit' under PUBLIC AMENITY. We are seeking to provide quality space for parents, carers and their young children. It is indoor and offers particular refuge in bad weather when accessing other activities is harder. (This stage of life can be isolating and depression can hit).

	Although our group is run by a church, it is for a <u>everyone</u>. The money will go towards hiring the centre, therefore helping us to continue. (Previously the Centre graciously gave us 6 months initially F.O.C.) We have no other grants for this venture. We have regularly (weekly) had 6 adults attend with their young.
